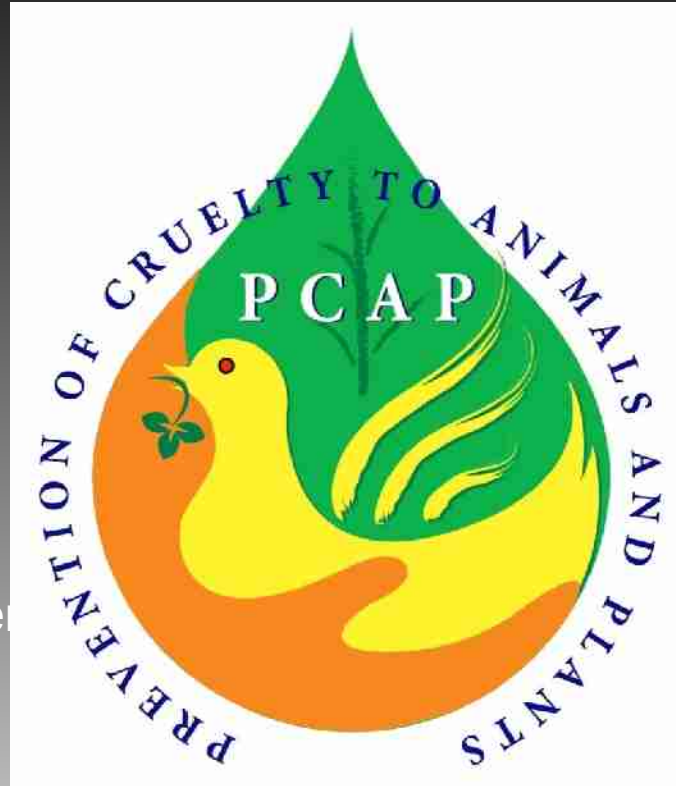

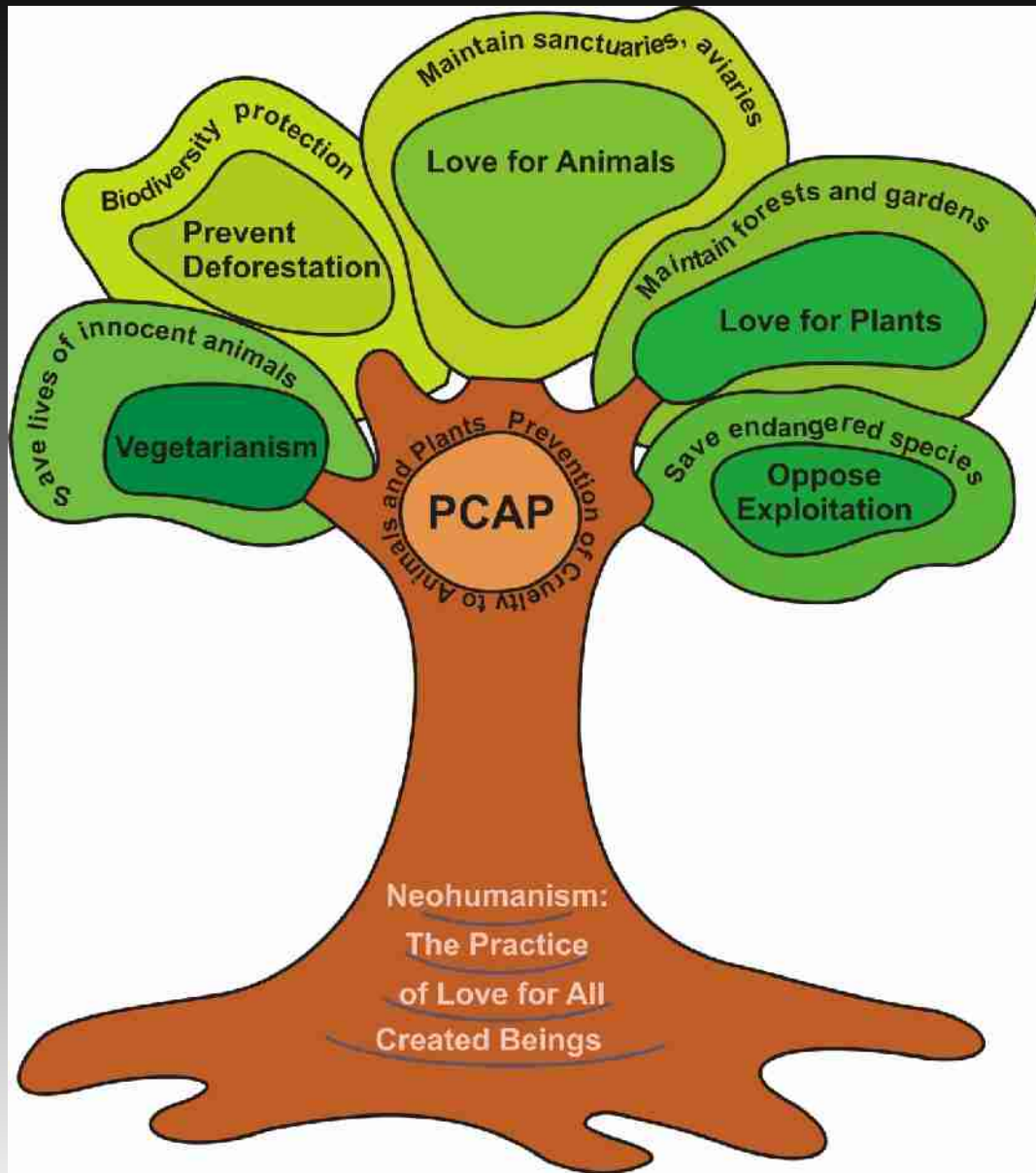

- Neohumanism is the practice of love for all created beings





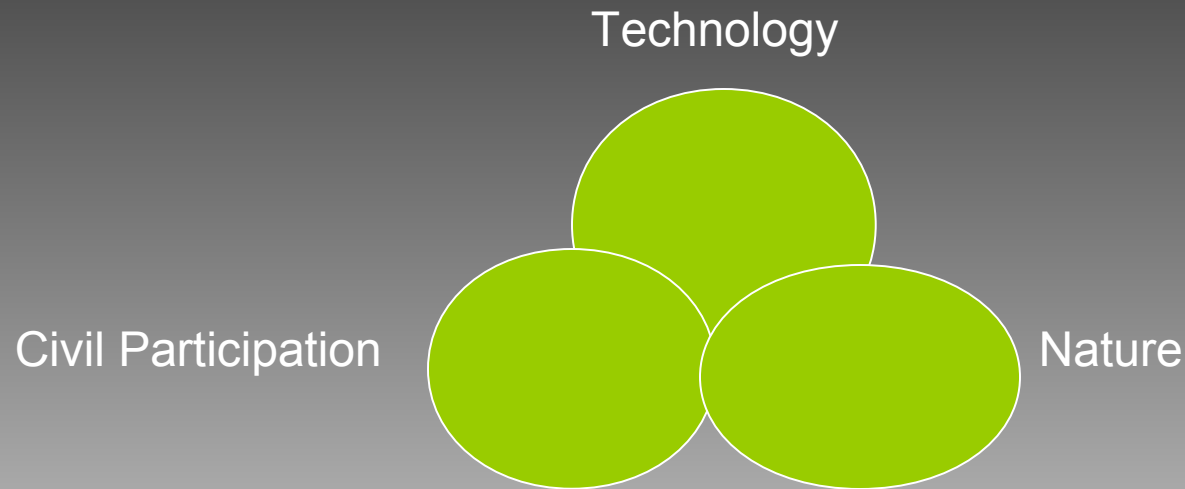

Other Objectives of PCAP

- To protect rare and dying species of animals, birds and plants from extinction.
- To create a sentiment of love for animals, birds and plants by popularizing their usefulness to human beings, society and the environment.
- To promote forest based products and industries for the economic upliftment of the poor, tribal and forest people.

Getting Started:

- Organize PCAP Study Circle
- Create local PCAP unit
- Prepare Ecology Poster(s)
- Prepare 2 leaflets:
 - A. Ecology and PCAP
 - B. Focus Area (tree planting, vegetarianism, etc.)

Level One Activities

- Planting trees
- Organizing vegetarian dinner
- Organizing vegetarian cooking classes
- Organizing clean up of local park, market, river or beach

Level Two Activities (Community Level)

- Give talk to local primary/high school on love of animals and plants
- Implement an action that addresses a local issue.
- Timing: global environmental dates, i.e. Earth Day, etc.
- Link with other local eco/animal welfare organizations
- Attend local eco related fairs, concerts, etc.

Level Three Activities

- Organize weekend seminar for youth centering on eco themes
- Mobilize neighbors for waste collection followed by garage sale

Level Four: NGO Level

- Open office
- Employ few part time staff
- Conduct a needs assessment in local area
- Identify local environmental needs and prepare proposal to implement project based on results of needs assessment
